Currently, the Glendora Municipal Code Section 9.36.010 (7) states unpaved parking is not permitted. Violation of this code requires immediate correction.

An unpaved surface is any area of land which is not paved for legal parking. This includes gravel, dirt, boards, grass and bricks not set in cement. Parking on an unpaved surface creates several safety concerns. Vehicles that are parked on unpaved surfaces can leak fluids onto the soil, causing environmental pollution and possible contamination of city water sources.

## **OVERNIGHT PARKING**

Early Morning Parking Permits can be purchased from vending machines in two locations.

- **1. Glendora Police Department** 150 S. Glendora Ave.
- **2. Gladstone Park** 630 E. Gladstone St.

Permits cost \$5 per vehicle, per early morning. The license plate number or vehicle identification number must be written on the permit and displayed face-up on the driver's side of the vehicle's dashboard.



## **DID YOU KNOW?**

The City of Glendora currently has an annual overnight street parking permit for residents who qualify. There is also a daily parking permit.

## THE PENALTY

Avoid getting a Parking Violation notice. The penalty for this violation may result in the issuance of a written citation to the property owner and current registered owner of the vehicle in violation including a fine.

## **ANNUAL PARKING PERMIT REQUIREMENTS**

- That all legal parking spaces are being fully utilized.
- All vehicles parked on property, including those in garage, are to be registered to the resident and maintained in an operative condition.
- All driver licenses and vehicle registrations must reflect the address that appears on the application.
- Eligible vehicles shall be passenger vehicles (not an RV, motorcycle, or commercial vehicle) that are driven or moved on a regular basis.
- The application shall be accompanied by a \$75.00 non refundable fee, copies of all
- current registrations / driver licenses and a plot plan of the property showing locations of all buildings/structures and parking areas.
